Arts & Design Pathway

(17 student maximum)

If you select the Arts & Design Pathway, you will participate in a variety of hands-on experiences and be introduced to concepts in the following areas:

Business, Communications & Tech Pathway

(17 student maximum)

If you select the Business, Communication & Tech Pathway, you will participate in a variety of hands-on experiences and be introduced to concepts in the following areas:

Health Sciences

(17 student maximum)

If you select the Health Sciences Pathway, you will participate in a variety of hands-on experiences and be introduced to concepts in the following areas:

- Wellness/Nutrition



STEM Pathway

(17 student maximum)

Early Bird Savings:

Apply on or before February 15 and save
 \$50 off the cost of tuition.

Application Tips:

- Review application form first.
- Gather necessary documents:
 - Essays
 - Resume
 - Reference & letter of recommendation
- Then complete & submit application.



Frequently Asked Questions

- What is the cost?
 - \$825 (Actual value of the program is \$1100/participant.)
- What's included?
 - Two college credits (average cost nationally is \$1,049 per credit), your stay in the residence hall, all meals and snacks, materials, program and activity fees.
- Are scholarships available?
 - Yes, a limited number of full and half scholarships are available for eligible students. Payment plans are also available. Contact Center for Women's Leadership with questions.
